Tuition Refund Policy

If a student withdraws from a course or from the college during the first three weeks after the start of the semester, a refund will be processed based on the date that the student withdraws.

If a student withdraws from a course or from the college, the student may receive a tuition refund for that session or semester provided an Add-Drop Form is completed and filed with the Admissions Office within a specified time, or the student withdraws online via SCC Connection. The date of the Add-Drop form or the date the online drop is completed is used to determine the percentage of eligible refund.

Percentage of Refund	Time Frame of Refund
100%	12:00 am on the 1st day of the semester through 11:59 pm on the 7th day.
80%	12:00 am on the 8th day of the semester through 11:59 pm on the 14th day.
60%	12:00 am on the 15th day of the semester through 11:59 pm on the 21st day.

NOTE: Refund amounts are determined by specific dates within each semester for all classes and will be prorated for courses less than 16 weeks in length.

A full refund of tuition and fees is made if the college cancels a scheduled class.
