



CHECKLIST FOR DOCUMENTS TO BE COMPLETED AND SENT TOGETHER TO
ISS@STCHAS.EDU IN A SINGLE EMAIL, OR AS FEW EMAILS AS POSSIBLE

1. Scanned copies of your **passport** to email or mail (see address and email address below)

2. **Send High school transcripts:** Submit copies of official transcripts of high school and college work to iss@stchas.edu or mail to St. Charles Community College at the address at the bottom of this page. The transcripts must be translated into English and include course descriptions and final grades with an explanation of the grading system

3. **Proof of Financial Ability (documents will be presented to International Student Services and at the Visa interview)**
 - a. **Part 1: Financial documents** (bank statement, retirement fund, or savings account stamped if from outside the US in English and less than one year old) to accompany the forms on pages 5 and 6 of this packet.
 - b. **Part 2:** Completed "**Financial Information and Agreement Form**" (See Page 5 below) **with an official stamp from a notary official and "Affidavit of Financial Support"** (see Page 6 below). Note: If you are unable to access a notary official near you, please contact the closest American embassy if you are outside of the United States and in need of a notary official. Please be sure to take your financial forms with you when you visit the notary official.

4. Non-native language proficiency test results: Non-native English speakers (*please see the Language Proficiency Form, Page 1, below, for native speaker and test information*), will kindly send English **Language Proficiency Test Results** to determine placement into an intensive, pathway, or degree program upon admissions. Note: Course schedules will be based on an assessment that will be completed after admission to the College. Send results to St. Charles Community College or iss@stchas.edu.

5. **Conditions of Enrollment Form:** Carefully read the **Conditions of Enrollment** (page 2, below) and sign (download and sign with a digital signature, or print, sign and email to iss@stchas.edu). You will be asked to sign this each semester.

6. **The Biographical Statement Form:** Complete the Biographical Statement form in this packet (Page 3, below) and email or mail it to International Student Services.

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY (check one):

Advanced ESL Test-Out Information: To bypass taking English Language Instruction, students must have:

- A 79 or higher on the TOEFL IBT or 550 on the TOEFL paper-based; minimum score of 6.5 on the IELTS; minimum 53 on Pearson PTE Academic; minimum C on the Cambridge CPE; Minimum B on the Cambridge CAE; minimum 110 on the Duolingo online; minimum 1200 on GTEC CBT. Email results to iss@stchas.edu
- *Those who graduated from American high schools and lived in the US for more than one year are exempt from taking ESL unless the pre-registration English assessment indicates ELL (English language learner) concerns, or the student requests assistance with English.*

ESL Pathway: To gain ESL (English as a Second Language) support for Associate degree-seeking students: Those under a 79 will complete ESL and general education assessment once they arrive at SCC. To be admitted for an Associate degree-seeking program with ESL support, students must achieve the following:

- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): 323 on the paper-based version, or 50 on the TOEFL IBT online test
- International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam: Minimum score of 5.5
- Duolingo: Minimum score of 80

Intensive English: Students whose scores are below those listed above for admission to degree-seeking programs may apply to the English Language and Culture Institute (ELCI) for language instruction. In this case, submit the language proficiency score or take a language proficiency test for placement into the ELCI program.

Students who wish to apply for the English Language and Culture Institute to take English classes without pursuing a degree may do so regardless of their English proficiency scores.

Native speakers on the following list of countries are exempt from taking ESL.

Those from other countries not on this list who wish to be admitted as a native speaker because English was a native language should write a 250-word appeal to have a language proficiency requirement waived and send it to iss@stchas.edu, Attn: Director.

Other:

- Complete the highest level of the SCC Intensive English Program through the English Language and Culture Institute at SCC, or
- Score a 5 or higher on the International Baccalaureate (IB) English A: Language & Literature HL exam
- Complete 24 or more transferable credits from an accredited two- or four-year post-secondary institution in the United States
- Complete English Composition with a C or better at an accredited two- or four-year post-secondary institution in the United States
- Graduate from an American high school and earn one of the following: a 19 or higher on the ACT in Reading and English, or an Advanced Placement (AP) score of 4 or 5 on either the English: Language and Composition or English: Literature and Composition exams (either of these AP scores will enable students to test into English Composition 102)



CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT

1. Acceptance to SCC does not guarantee an I-20 or student VISA, final decision is made by USCIS.
2. Students must be enrolled in a degree program (certificate must be attached to a degree), maintain a minimum of 2.0 GPA, and make academic progress in their degree program to complete by the end date listed on their I-20.
3. To apply for an extension, students must provide documentation of the reason to extend the program and submit it for approval to a Designated Student Officer (DSO).
4. All International Students must be enrolled in (12) credit hours to remain in status and enrolled at the College.
5. Students must attend class regularly and follow each professor's attendance policy, and students who are reported as not attending may be administratively withdrawn from course, resulting in the cancellation of their I-20 if they fall below a full course of study.
6. Students are responsible for housing and transportation.
7. Students should arrive ten days before the beginning of the semester and follow check-in procedures.
8. Students must complete the TB Screening Form and Test before classes begin.
9. International Students are required to purchase health insurance from an approved vendor, and ISS will provide students with purchase information. Insurance must be purchased by the semester.
10. Students will be charged "out of state" tuition rates, and students are required to pay or make payment arrangements by the due date each semester.
11. Changes of information such as address or course of study changes must be reported to a DSO within five days of the change, and students should allow DSOs ten days to complete the update to their I-20.
12. Students must fill out a travel form and obtain a DSO's signature before traveling outside of the United States. Students must complete a travel form a minimum of ten days before traveling and send to iss@stchas.edu.
13. Students must register for classes with a DSO.
14. Students will be charged fees as outlined on the College website and in publications.
15. Students must complete an employment, OPT, or CPT form and meet with a DSO before pursuing work opportunities (on-campus, for CPT, OPT).
16. International students do not qualify for federal financial aid or federal work-study programs, but may apply for scholarships.
17. Students must arrange to ship and pay for their I-20 if requested to do so.
18. Students may not drop a main-semester class and enroll in a second eight-week semester class.
19. First semester students must meet regularly with a DSO.
20. Students must maintain contact and respond to Designated Student Officers by checking SCC email regularly and reporting changes of contact information, such as phone numbers and addresses.
21. As part of the ISS Honor Code, students must treat themselves and others with respect, and students who violate SCC policies and procedures, or the State or federal law, or who fail to maintain agreements with SCC and SCC affiliates (including Campus Lake Housing and insurance affiliates) are subject to suspension or disciplinary action.

Failure to abide by the above-stated policies can result in the student's probation from SCC and termination of the student's I-20.
