Scholarship Criteria

- Students of African American, African, Asian, Hispanic, or Native American descent enrolled at St. Charles Community College (SCC).
- Minimum Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or most recent SCC semester GPA of 2.5 or above.
- Enrolled*
 - Full-time (minimum 12 credit hours) or
 - Part-time (minimum 6 credit hours)
- Essay
- Two References
- SCC transcript

***Must be enrolled in the semester receiving the scholarship and the semester applying for the scholarship**
