# Dates AND DEADLINES

## FEBRUARY

Begin your financial aid application process once your taxes are complete. You can start by completing a FAFSA application at [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov).

Trustee and Foundation scholarship applications are due **March 1**, so February is the time to start filling them out. Download applications at [stchas.edu/scholarships](http://stchas.edu/scholarships), or visit Enrollment Services in the Administration Building for help.
